## Rose BUSSEY (1810-1860)

Rose was aged 47, could read, a general servant from Norfolk when migrating to Tasmania with her husband and five children on the 'Trade Wind' in 1858. Rose and her husband, William Bussey, were sponsored by Edward Cummings of Launceston.

Rose was known under several names in different records including Rosalie, Rosetta, Roscattia and Rosina. Rose was born on 27 September 1810 in East Larling in Norfolk, England. Her parents were James Ludkin (1755-1827) and Sarah nee Bussey (1769-1828).

Rose and William were married on 6 January 1839 in Larling, Norfolk.
