

Elizabeth HAMPSTED (1842-1930)


Elizabeth was aged 16, single, could read and a housemaid when arriving in Tasmania. Elizabeth was born on 19 March 1842 at Combs, Stowmarket in Suffolk. Her father, Robert, was a labourer at the time of her birth and the family lived at Combs.
