

Ellen (aka Cutting) QUARRY (1856-1944)

Ellen was baptised on 20 September 1857 in Buckworth, Huntingdon, England. She was too young to remember her journey to Tasmania on the 'Trade Wind' in 1858 as she was only aged 10 months. Her parents were Thomas (1823-1909) and Ann (nee Clarke 1824-1911) and her siblings: Arthur (1847-1919), Fanny (Agatha Frances 1849-1934), William (Henry 1851-1936), Susan (Louisa Susan 1853-1891), and Emma (1854-1923). They were sponsored by J S Waddell of Launceston, most likely Joseph Stammers Waddell, Jun.

Ellen married William Price (1851-1906) in the home of her father, Thomas Christmas Quarry on 16 April 1881, in Launceston. Her husband's occupation on wedding registration was 'gentleman' which normally meant he was not working and had an independent income. William and Ellen had at least six children, all born in Launceston, Tasmania.

After William's death in 1906, aged 55, Ellen moved to Petersham in New South Wales. She died at Five Dock in 1944, aged 86.
