

Ellinor (Elleanor) TURNER (1847-1927)

Elleanor was aged 10 when migrating to Tasmania with her family on the 'Trade Wind' in 1858. She was born about 1847 in Hockham, Norfolk.

Elleanor married William Huttley (1844-1920) on 16 July 1868 in Launceston, Tasmania. William was the son of William Sen. (1813-1894) and Jane nee Downton (1813-1891). William Sen. and Jane had migrated from England per 'Boliviar' in 1842.

Elleanor and William had six children. Three children died in infancy and another who was aged 28. A daughter, Ivy May (1892-1969), remained in Tasmania and the surviving son, Ernest Albert (1880-1946) moved to Sydney.

Elleanor died at her residence, 297 Brisbane Street, Launceston, on 1 August 1927, aged 80. Her husband predeceased her by seven years. He died on 11 December 1920 at Launceston, aged 76.
