

Henry TURNER (1843-1927)

Henry was aged 14, a labourer from Norfolk when migrating on the 'Trade Wind' to Tasmania in 1858 with his parents, Jacob and Jane Turner.

Henry was baptised on 14 May 1843 in Hingham, Norfolk. It is possible Henry (Henry William) married Sarah Ann Bailey in Queensland on 1 April 1863. It is believed he died on 15 April 1927 in Queensland. The Queensland death registration records the names of his parents as Jacob Turner and Jane Clarke. It is not uncommon for relatives to give incorrect information about deceased people and presumably Jane may have said she was the daughter of Benjamin Clarke – and she may well have been – her birth being prior to her mother's marriage to Benjamin Clarke on 5 November 1823 would explain why the name of the father was not given.
